

Proposition



Solvency (proof that the plan work)

- \$180 Billion, California farm workers contribute to the economy (PRI, 2017)
- Farm workers will have equal rights like any other employee in the U.S. by getting paid overtime after the 8th hour



Disadvantages

- People could overstay their visa
- Apprehension could become one of the biggest expenses for ICE
 -\$3.2 Billion (CNN Money, 2017)
- Fruits would be more expensive due to the cost of working overtime
